How does timed ticketing work?

Your purchased timeslot is the timeframe for you to enter the event. You can stay as long as you want! We will offer "standby" tickets at event check-in, so don't worry if a friend wants to tag along at the last minute.

Where do I park?

Parking for the event will be in our regular lot, located at 1000 Gunpowder Point Dr, Chula Vista, and it will be free of charge! Once parked, please check in at the Living Coast canopy. From there, you will receive directions for taking the shuttle to the center. The shuttle will run on a continuous loop; you can return to your vehicle at any time. All rideshares and taxis must be dropped off at the parking lot, and the shuttle must be taken in.
